

INSPIRACIÓN DE LA SEMANA

Muchos seguidores de Jesús no pudieron aceptar sus enseñanzas. A los que se quedaron les hizo una simple pregunta: “¿Ustedes también quieren irse?” Nos pregunta lo mismo, en cada momento de cada día. Respondamos con confianza, en todo lo que hagamos: “Sólo tú tienes palabras de vida eterna.”

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

Algunos de los seguidores de Jesús no pudieron creer lo que les dijo. Era demasiado para ellos: “*Mi carne es verdadera comida y mi sangre es verdadera bebida*” (Juan 6:55). A pesar de que Jesús lo explicaba de muchas maneras, algunos decidieron abandonarlo. Él no hizo nada por detenerlos, los dejó libres respetando su decisión. Después de esos acontecimientos de abandono, Jesús pregunta directamente a los doce: “*¿Quieren marcharse también ustedes? Pedro le contestó: Señor, ¿a quién iríamos? Tú tienes palabras de vida eterna. Nosotros creemos y sabemos que tú eres el Santo de Dios*” (Juan 6:67-69). Ahora, en la realidad que vivimos tan llena de ruido y modernidad, ¿sabemos a dónde vamos, a quién dirigirnos? Pedro, lo supo y el deseo de la Iglesia es que sepamos que solo Jesús tiene palabras de vida eterna. Y que su Pan de Vida se nos da gratuitamente en la Eucaristía.

“*La Eucaristía y la cruz son piedras de tropiezo. Es el mismo misterio, y no cesa de ser ocasión de división. ¿Quieren marcharse también ustedes? (Juan 6:67): esta pregunta del Señor resuena a través de las edades, como invitación de su amor a descubrir que sólo Él tiene palabras de vida eterna (Juan 6:68), y que acoger en la fe el don de su Eucaristía es acogerlo a Él mismo*”. RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS

La Plenitud de la Vida

Como cualquier otra niña de los años 90 criada por padres preocupados por su presupuesto, he pasado una buena parte de los domingos por la mañana haciendo cola en un “Old Country Buffet,” con un plato caliente en la mano. Los domingos los niños comían por unas monedas, y yo nunca salía de ese excelente establecimiento sin sacar provecho de nuestro dinero. Siempre salía llena hasta los huesos. Pero nunca recuerdo haberme sentido satisfecha. De hecho, si mal no recuerdo, la mayor parte del tiempo me sentí bastante vacía. Siempre estaba pensando en la comida que no pude comer: lo que no cabía en mi plato o lo que traían de la cocina justo cuando estábamos a punto de irnos. A medida que he crecido, es una sensación que he encontrado una y otra vez, y no sólo en los buffets. ¿No lo hemos hecho todos? Las personas que crees que son perfectas se revelan profundamente defectuosas. Las cosas que más deseas nunca son tan satisfactorias de poseer como de anhelar. Las experiencias que más anticipas terminan siendo decepciones, cuando en cambio son los momentos ordinarios (tal vez incluso los momentos difíciles, los momentos dolorosos) los que se destacan y se convierten en recuerdos preciados.

Las lecturas de las Escrituras de hoy equivalen la sabiduría y la plenitud con la aceptación de algo que no tiene sentido, que desafía la explicación científica, las normas culturales e incluso el sentido común: la Presencia Real de nuestro Dios en la Eucaristía. ¿Es extraño creer que estamos consumiendo el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo en nuestra adoración, y que sólo así alcanzaremos la vida eterna? Tal vez. Pero como cristianos se nos pide que hagamos muchas cosas extrañas. Se nos pide amar cuando no tenemos ganas de amar, cuando el objeto de ese amor no se lo ha ganado. Se nos pide que perdonemos incluso cuando quien recibe ese perdón no lo busca ni lo merece. Se nos pide que creamos, en momentos en que creer parece imposible. Sócrates dice que la única sabiduría está en saber que no se sabe nada. Quizás la única plenitud espiritual esté en saber que aquí en este mundo sólo hay vacío, que no existe ninguna experiencia física o indulgencia que realmente pueda hacerte sentir satisfecho y fuerte. Que el único alimento que realmente te nutre de forma duradera es una pequeña Hostia blanca que apenas puedes saborear en la lengua. “*Mi carne es verdadera comida y mi sangre es verdadera bebida.*” — Juan 6:55 ©LPi

INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Many followers of Jesus could not accept his teachings. To those that remained, he posed a simple question: “Do you also want to leave?” He asks us the same, every moment of every day. Let us answer with confidence, in all that we do: “Only you have the words of eternal life.”

GOSPEL MEDITATION

The famous Russian novelist Fyodor Dostoyevsky said, “Love in action is a harsh and dreadful thing.” In the Gospel reading this week, Jesus does something harsh and dreadful — he watches his own disciples abandon him. What could possibly be loving about that?

Well, we notice the context is Jesus’ teaching about eating and drinking his body and blood. His followers hear this and say, “**This teaching is difficult; who can accept it?**” (John 6:60). We shouldn’t imagine we’d do anything different, because not even the ones who stay, like Peter, seem to understand what Jesus is saying. Then we hear this devastating line, “**Because of this many of his disciples turned back and no longer went about with him**” (John 6:66). Besides the night of the Last Supper, only now do Jesus’ disciples abandon him. And, painfully, Jesus just lets them go.

The best way to make sense out of this is love. Jesus is God’s love in action. He wants to become one with those whom He loves. He wants to love them as His own body. Yes, the oneness manifested in the Eucharist sounds harsh and dreadful because it is rooted in love which is willing to risk abandonment and separation to attain its goal: to be one body with the beloved. It is both terrifying and wonderful that Jesus will risk losing us in order to be one with us. Our response? Lord, we cannot grasp a love so great, but please help us never to abandon it, either. —Father John Muir

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

To Whom Shall We Go?

A friend of mine, who is a far better Christian than I can ever hope to be, once shared with me that her family sneers at her belief system and lifestyle. She believes in fairy tales they tell her. She’s looking for simple solutions from a kind-faced man in the sky because she doesn’t want to grapple with complicated answers to complicated problems. Religion, they argue, is the easy way out. As she spoke about this, her voice became unsteady. Not with anger, but with emotion. “I would never call this life easy,” she said. “If I was looking for something that was easy, I wouldn’t choose Catholicism.”

What was unspoken was *why* she has chosen Catholicism. I know the answer, but only because I know her. I knew her before she chose it wholeheartedly, and I know her now, and I see the difference. I see that these words are written so clearly across the days of her life: “Master, to whom shall we go?” Once the truth is known in your soul, you see, it can never be unknown.

Following Christ is not about easy answers and simple teachings. Sure, it all sounds very basic: love one another as I have loved you. What could be more straightforward? But what does that mean? What does that look like in daily, modern life, in a world full of the fallen, whose flaws have given us rough edges and weakened wills?

I’ll tell you what it looks like — it looks like a struggle. It looks like failure and mess and confusion and losing your way and finding it again, all because you remembered that within you there is a compass pointing due north. It’s a constant state of wandering in the dark, following a Voice that asks you to go where you’re afraid to go. And you follow the Voice not because it’s the only voice there is and not because it’s the voice that says what you want to hear, but because it’s the only one that speaks the truth, and the truth pulls on you in a way you can’t quite resist. When Christ asks, “Do you also want to leave?” he is not gaslighting us. It’s a genuine question. We are free to go. We are not prisoners. But we have heard the words of everlasting life, and now we can only have peace if we follow where they lead. “*As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.*” — Joshua 24:15 ©LPi

MAKING THE RIGHT CHOICE

There comes a time in our life when we have to make important choices – choices that may have a repercussion on our state of life, our profession or work at hand, our plans and goals. The most fundamental choice concerns our relationship with Jesus Christ. We are constantly challenged to choose between faithfulness to his teachings and the allurements of the hedonistic world in which we are immersed. This is a choice that demands both wisdom and generosity.

"Do you also want to leave?" Simon Peter answered him, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God." Wisdom leads us to stand by Jesus. Generosity enables us to pay the price for choosing to follow Jesus. We experience in life that we have to make a lot of choices. When it is an important matter our first consideration should always be what does God want me to do? In the light of the gospel, what decision should I take? The choice is not always easy or clear.
