<p>Santo de la semana</p> <p>San Pablo, el Apóstol de los Gentiles, fue el misionero cristiano más prolífico de todos los tiempos. Debido a una experiencia milagrosa que tuvo en el camino a Damasco, pasó de perseguir a los primeros cristianos a viajar por toda la región predicando el Evangelio de Jesús.</p> <p>Oración en tiempos de oscuridad</p> <p>Querido Jesús, Cuando me sienta preocupado, solo, asustado, quédate conmigo. Sé un destello de llama en esta oscuridad. Ayúdame a conocerme en las estaciones difíciles como lo hago yo en tiempos de euforia. Eres la luz que busco. Amén.</p>	<p>Saint of the Week</p> <p>St. Paul, the Apostle to the Gentiles, was the most prolific Christian missionary of all time. Due to a miraculous experience that he had on the road to Damascus, he went from persecuting early Christians to traveling all over the region preaching the Gospel of Jesus.</p> <p>Prayer in Times of Darkness</p> <p>Dear Jesus, When I feel troubled, alone, frightened, be with me. Be a flicker of flame in this darkness. Help me to know you in the stark seasons as I do in times of elation. You are the light I seek. Amen.</p>
<p>MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO – ALENTAR UN ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA</p> <p>Si me pides que te cuente acerca de uno de mis hijos, mi hija, o mi esposa, podría pasar mucho tiempo hablando de ellos como individuos y de mis interacciones con ellos a través de los años. Una relación auténtica nos lleva a todos hacia un conocimiento profundo uno del otro. Si tengo poco que decir de alguien, que no sea información accidental o chisme, no puedo decir que lo conozco bien.</p> <p>Claro, en todas las relaciones hay expectativas. Si no sabemos las necesidades del otro o las respuestas esperadas de una relación, podemos fácilmente crear una división y separación. Hago ciertas cosas para mis hijos porque soy un padre. Respondo en ciertas maneras a mi esposa dependiendo de sus necesidades. Si actuó de manera inconsciente, o no me importa, la relación seguirá hacia un camino de dolor, de daños, y en algunas instancias, de separación permanente.</p> <p>Conocer a Jesús es amar a Jesús, lo importante es conocerlo. Conocerlo es escuchar a sus palabras y seguir sus mandamientos. Como en todas las relaciones a veces short no alcanzamos a cumplir las expectativas. Sin embargo, como sabemos podemos compensar las expectativas y continuar creciendo juntos. Y si yo te pidiera que me contararas sobre ese amigo tuyo que se llama Jesús, qué dirías? --Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS ©LPi</p>	<p>GOSPEL MEDITATION – ENCOURAGE A DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE</p> <p>The famous “Road to Emmaus” story recounts, on that first Sunday of the Resurrection, the basic two-fold structure of the Mass: <i>Word</i>, followed by <i>Eucharist</i>. Jesus spends a significant period of time with two dismayed disciples, as he connects a wide swath of the Hebrew scriptures with his own suffering, death, and resurrection. They would later report that this Liturgy of the Word touched their hearts with an inexplicable fire. This Word-induced flame alone is what leads the two disciples to discover Jesus’ presence in the “breaking of the bread.”</p> <p>With this in mind, how can we possibly think that the Liturgy of the Word is unnecessary or incidental? The two disciples needed the Scriptures explained to them in order to experience Jesus alive in the eucharistic breaking of bread. Sure, we say, but they had the Risen Jesus. But that’s precisely the point: Jesus is risen and accompanies us in both parts of the Mass. Imagine how much our experience of Jesus in the Eucharist would deepen if we (preachers and listeners) took even more seriously that Jesus himself sets our hearts ablaze with his Word so that we know him in the Eucharist. <p>RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS Por Colleen Jurkiewicz Dorman</p> <p>El Giro Final</p> <p>Cualquier lector de novelas de suspense psicológicos se encontrará con bastante frecuencia con el “tropo del personaje principal muerto.” Este es el famoso final del <i>Sexto Sentido</i> (yo diría “alerta de spoiler,” pero la película es más antigua que la mayoría de las personas que trabajan en el Ministerio Juvenil en tu arquidiócesis, así que probablemente ya la hayas visto) donde el lector encuentra que el personaje principal ha estado muerto durante toda o la mayor parte de la historia.</p> <p>Siempre me siento un poco decepcionada cuando esto sucede. Ofrece un valor impactante, claro, pero también socava todo lo que sucede en la historia. Has emprendido un viaje con este personaje, solo para descubrir que nada de lo que viste fue real de la manera que pensabas. Te sientes un poco estúpido, porque todo el tiempo sólo tuviste parte de la verdad.</p> <p>Sospecho que Jesús sabe esto acerca de nosotros. Él sabe que no nos gusta que nos “muevan el tapete.” Es por eso que es tan sincero acerca de su humanidad después de la resurrección. Mira cómo Jesús, resucitado, muestra a los discípulos sus pies, sus manos. Mira cómo les pide comida y les deja verlo comer. Ves cómo esto crea en ellos una comprensión, una creencia.</p> <p>La humanidad de Jesucristo es absolutamente crucial. Es lo que cierra la brecha entre los hijos de Eva y el Dios que ella desafió. Nuestra reconciliación con Dios no puede ocurrir a menos que la carne humana pague el precio que equilibrará la balanza. Carne humana: piel que puede desgarrarse y sangrar, huesos que pueden romperse, una boca que puede tener sed, un estómago que puede doler de hambre. La pasión y muerte de Jesucristo no es una novela de suspense con un final inesperado; ¡fue un fantasma todo el tiempo! El giro, en todo caso, es este: fue humano todo el tiempo. “Tóquenme y convéñanse: un fantasma no tiene ni carne ni huesos, como ven que tengo yo.” — Lucas 24:39 ©LPi</p>	<p>RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS By Colleen Jurkiewicz Dorman</p> <p>The Twist Ending</p> <p>Any reader of psychological thrillers will come across the “dead main character trope” fairly often. This is the famous <i>Sixth Sense</i> twist ending (I would say “spoiler alert,” but the movie is older than most of the people who work in Youth Ministry at your archdiocese, so you’ve probably seen it by now) where the reader finds that the main character has been dead for all or most of the story.</p> <p>I’m always a little disappointed when this happens. It delivers shock value, sure, but it also undermines everything that happens in the story. You’ve come on a journey with this character, only to find out that nothing you saw transpire was real in the way you thought it was. You feel a little stupid, because the whole time you only had part of the truth.</p> <p>I suspect Jesus knows this about us. He knows we don’t like to have the rug pulled out. It’s why he is so up-front about his humanity following the resurrection. See how Jesus, resurrected, shows the disciples his feet, his hands. See how he asks them for food and lets them watch him eat it. See how this creates in them an understanding, a belief.</p> <p>The humanity of Jesus Christ is absolutely crucial. It’s what bridges the divide between the sons of Eve and the God she defied. Our reconciliation with God cannot happen unless human flesh pays the price that will balance the scales. Human flesh: skin that can tear and bleed, bones that can break, a mouth that can thirst, a stomach that can ache with hunger.</p> <p>The passion and death of Jesus Christ is not a thriller with a twist ending: <i>he was a ghost the whole time!</i> The twist, if anything, is this: he was human the whole time. “Touch me and see, because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have.” ©LPi</p>

On this Third Sunday of Easter we journey with Jesus along with the two disciples of Emmaus to be enlightened by his explanation of the Scriptures and strengthened in our faith. 
