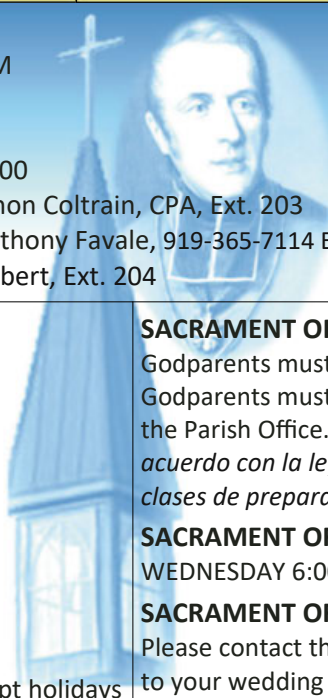

Amor en Hechos

¿Que Bello es Vivir! es una de mis películas navideñas favoritas. En la película conocemos a un joven, George Bailey, que sueña con crecer y hacer cosas asombrosas e impresionantes. A lo largo de los años, toma una decisión aquí y otra allá...y, al fin y al cabo, el George Bailey adulto es un marido y padre cansado y con exceso de trabajo, sin atributos mundanos que nadie pueda envidiar. Pero es un hombre que ha amado con hechos, no sólo con palabras, y que ha cosechado las recompensas espirituales de esas decisiones. La temporada de Pascua se trata de regocijarnos en la verdadera redención, no en el triunfo mundano. La Palabra de Dios no es un cuento antes de dormir. Es una tijera de podar. Escucharla es cambiar, ser formado. Vivirla es perder algunas cosas, para poder florecer de maneras inesperadas. Acoger la Palabra es estar dispuesto a verse diferente, a sentirse diferente. Cualquiera puede decir: “Te amo, te acepto, quiero ayudarte.” Pero ¿cómo es realmente amar de hecho y no sólo de palabra? Se ve como renunciar a algo: tiempo libre, riqueza, comodidad, aprobación mundana. Al observador casual le parece doloroso. Para alguien que no tiene idea de cómo crecen y prosperan las plantas, las tijeras de podar de un jardinero parecen la espada de un verdugo. Para alguien que no tiene idea de cómo crecen y prosperan las almas, una tumba cerrada con una piedra parece el final de una historia, cuando en realidad es sólo el comienzo. *“Hijos míos: No amemos solamente de palabra, amemos de verdad y con las obras.” — 1 Juan 3:18* ©LPi

**GOSPEL MEDITATION – ENCOURAGE A DEEPER
UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE**

My friend and fellow pastor, Father Paul, noticed unsightly, overgrown trees near his parish church. He asked the maintenance crew to cut back the growth, which they happily did, telling him the trees would be much healthier and even fuller after a good pruning. A few days later, Father Paul received a letter from an irate man in the neighborhood who wrote, “Jesus would never prune trees like that. He loves trees, unlike you.”

I suspect that the neighbor was not familiar with this week's Gospel in which Jesus says of his Father, **“He removes every branch in me that bears no fruit. Every branch that bears fruit he prunes to make it bear more fruit”** (John 15:2) I don't mean to pick too much on that fellow. He was perhaps ignorant of arboriculture. But I'd wager his main confusion was the pruning and removing quality of God's love. That confusion afflicts us all to some degree, doesn't it? It is just so darn easy to react negatively when God cuts something out of our lives and assume it's not his work at all. In the moment, all we see is the loss, and not the loving desire for future flourishing. The cross is the great pruning of Christ's body. Jesus' rising is the brand-new growth. It is God's promise to us that all the painful pruning in life is leading us somewhere beautiful. What has been cut back or out in your life? A friend, an opportunity, a sense of certainty, a job, health, a relationship? This week, offer those dry branches to the one who lovingly prunes us in order to make our lives burst with verdant growth. - Father John Muir ©LPi

Love in Deed

It's a Wonderful Life is one of my favorite Christmas movies. It only occurred to me recently, though, that this film, for all its yuletide aesthetic, is actually more of an Easter story. I love this movie because it's a very Catholic film — not overtly, although we do see the main character, George Bailey, going to Mass. No, it's the themes that are Catholic, not the set dressing. It's a story about the choices we make — to love, or not to love? To sacrifice, or not to sacrifice? To put oneself first, or to put oneself last? It's a story about what the consequences of those choices look like here in the world, and what they look like in heaven. In the film, we meet a young George Bailey who dreams of growing up to do amazing, impressive things. Over the years, he makes a choice here and he makes a choice there ... and when all is said and done, the adult George Bailey is a tired, overworked husband and father with no worldly attributes that anyone would envy.

But he's a man who has loved in deed, not just in word, and who has reaped the spiritual rewards of those choices. The season of Easter is about rejoicing in true redemption, not in worldly triumph. The Word of God is not a bedtime story. It's a pruning shear. To hear it is to be changed, to be shaped. To live it is to lose some things, so that you might bloom in unexpected ways. To welcome the Word is to be willing to look different, to feel different. Anyone can say, “I love you, I accept you, I want to help you.” But what does it actually look like, to love in deed and not just in word? It looks like giving something up: free time, wealth, comfort, worldly approval. It looks, to the casual observer, like pain. To someone who has no concept of how plants grow and thrive, a gardener's pruning shears look like an executioner's sword. To someone who has no concept of how souls grow and thrive, a tomb barred by a stone looks like the end of a story, when in fact it's just the beginning. *“Children, let us love not in word or speech, but in deed and truth.” — 1 John 3:18*

THE GREATEST "CONNECTION"

"I am the vine, you are the branches," Jesus tells us in today's Gospel passage. This is not "a way of speaking" but a "way of BEING," a wonderful reality, for at our baptism we have been grafted onto him. It is thanks to our deep union with Jesus that we can enjoy God's salvation and produce the fruits worthy of our new life in him.

Jesus' statement that "apart from him we can do nothing" may hurt our pride, but it is the sober truth. Only those who accept it in all humility and live accordingly can experience the joy of being God's children, and are in the best position to produce an abundance of fruits unto eternal life.

The preservation and growth of our union with our Lord Jesus Christ can happen only on one condition: that we keep his commandments. (See 1 Jn 3:24.) Then shall we bear the abundant fruits of the new life inaugurated by Jesus with his resurrection, especially the fruits of peace, and the genuine love of neighbor which expresses itself "in deeds and truth and not merely in words" (1 Jn 3:18.19). Then shall we enjoy the presence of the Holy Spirit in us, as it happened to the members of the apostolic community (see Acts 9:31, and 1 Jn 3:24), and continually experience in ourselves the reality and the power of Christ's Resurrection. (See Phil 3:10.)

Question of the Week:

Do you try to live a life of intimate union with Christ? Are you fruitful? What is the fruit of your union with Christ who dwells in you?

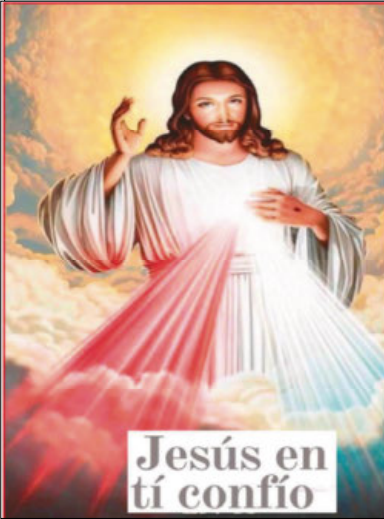
