Student Placement for Faith Formation at Saint Eugene Church

Effective April 1, 2025

1st/2nd Grade Year 1: Any child up to grade 2, baptized or not and has not yet received First Holy Communion. This would be the 1st year of formation. Non baptized children will receive baptism on Easter Sunday.

2nd/**3**rd **Grade Year 2:** Any child up to grade 3 who has completed Year 1 is Baptized and has not yet received First Holy Communion. This would be the 2nd Year of Formation.

FHC Yr. 1 & Cont. Grades 3-5th: All children in 3rd-5th grade continuing faith formation whom have already received First Communion and children whom are in 3rd-5th grade and will be in their first year of First Communion prep. Non baptized children will receive baptism on Easter Sunday.

FHC Yr 2 4th-5th: Children who are in 4th-5th grade and will be in their second year of First Communion prep. This would be the 2nd Year of Formation.

FHC Middle School & Cont. Grades 6-8th: All children in 6th-8th grade continuing faith formation who have already received First Communion and children who are in 6-8th grade and will be in their first year of First Communion prep. Non baptized children will receive baptism on Easter Sunday. Students who are in 8th grade will complete one year of First Communion prep and then move on to Confirmation Prep to receive both sacraments after Year 2 of Confirmation Prep.

FHC Middle School Yr 2 6th-8th: Children who are in 6th-8th grade and will be in their second year of First Communion prep.

Confirmation Prep 1 Grades 9th-11th: teens who are in grades 9th-11th and are in their first year of confirmation prep. This includes 9th-11th grade who need Baptism and/or First Communion.

Confirmation Prep 2 Grades 10th-**12**th: teens who are in grades 10-11 have completed Prep 1 requirements. Students who need first communion and confirmation will receive both sacraments at Confirmation Mass. Students who need baptism, first communion, and confirmation will receive them at Easter Vigil.

OCIC: students in 9th-11th grade have completed confirmation year 1 prep and do not have First Communion will have to take this in the summer between year 1 and year 2 prep.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE TWO-YEAR PROGRAMS ARE A MINIMUM AND NOT AN ABSOLUTE, ANY CHILD THAT IS FOUND TO NOT BE READY FOR THE SACRAMENT WILL BE REQUIRED TO TAKE A THIRD YEAR. A MEETING WITH THE PASTOR, FAITH FORMATION DIRECTOR AND PARENTS WILL BE CONDUCTED BEFORE THIS DECISION IS MADE.
