Confirmation 2 Requirements

- A copy of Baptism and First Communion certificates are needed.
- If Baptized at St. Eugene, WE DO NOT REQUIRE A COPY.

Class

- No more than 3 excused or unexcused absences
- 4 or more will require a meeting with parent, director and pastor to discuss continuing the program
- Curriculum: Chosen: Your journey to confirmation, Bible, Catechism

Mass

- Use envelopes to keep track of Mass attendance
- Will complete homily notes and turn in each week, parents to sign before submitting them.

Saint Project: Due by Jan 31st.

- All students are to research a Catholic saint and pick one to be their personal patron saint
- Students are given freedom to use their talents to explain why they picked the saint and some info on the saint.
- Project should teach students how to evangelize to others using their knowledge of the saint.
- Any student that does not turn in a Saint Name by this date will automatically have St Eugene as their saint name.

• Letter of Intent: Due by Dec 7th

• Community Service hours: Due by March 14th

- 20 hours of service to be completed in church functions
- Opportunities are sent out via flocknote or can consult the parish bulletin for specific ministries the teen might be interested in
- If you lose your sheet, you lose the hours. Make it a habit to snap a
 pic of it.
- Hours are due 1 month before Confirmation Mass

Evaluating Progress

- Catechist: will evaluate during class sessions and consult director
- Director: will be visiting classes and evaluating through discussions, and questions
- Pastor: will evaluate through classroom visits, discussions, questions and during the "Chill with the pastor" events.
- Any teen found to need more time to prepare for the sacrament of confirmation may be asked to complete an additional "catch up" year after discussion with parent, director, and pastor.

Meetings:

- Periodically we will have a casual class "chill with the pastor" during their normal class times and day. This will give the pastor to speak to our teens and get to know them as they get to know him. This will be an opportunity for them to ask the pastor questions as well. We may ask parents to come and help at this event but we ask parents to allow this to be a time for the teens and to request an appointment for any questions/concerns for the pastor.
- Parent Meeting: Parent meetings are mandatory, if a parent cannot make it, please send someone to represent you and can take notes for you.

Sponsors: Due by Jan 31st

- Only one sponsor will be allowed, unless they are baptismal godparents.
- All church guidelines must apply to sponsor to qualify: all three sacraments of initiation, and if married must be in the Catholic church.
